

AFTERSCHOOL ENRICHMENT WINTER/SPRING 2017

MONDAY CLASSES

MON: Typing (2-5) \$90 Dates: 2/6, 2/13, 2/27, 3/6, 3/13, 3/20, 3/27, 4/3 (Make-up 4/24)

Students will learn from Mrs. Bossio the basics and advance their typing skills which will help develop techniques and speed that benefit them for school assignments, district and state tests, and the future. Students will be so engaged in the typing lessons that they will forget they are learning! After typing, students will have time to practice by playing some games on the computer. **NO VOLUNTEER NEEDED**

MON: Middlebrook Milers Running Club (3-5) \$100 Dates: 2/27, 3/6, 3/13, 3/20, 3/27, 4/3 (Make-up 4/24)

The emphasis of this running club is on having fun while running, not on competitive running. Stretching techniques, proper running form and the safe development of endurance levels will be taught. The importance of setting and achieving goals, maintaining a positive attitude and living a healthy lifestyle will also be encouraged. At the end of the session, children will celebrate by running a timed 5K (3.1 miles). If a race is decided on, a parent/guardian must accompany the child on race day.
